

## **BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE (BYOD) – GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT USE OF PERSONAL TECHNOLOGY**

A color code system will be used to help insure appropriate use of personal technology devices within the school. The code may change in a classroom from day to day or period to period depending on the class activities for the day.

A red zone means that students can have their devices but they must be silent and out of sight.

A yellow zone means that devices are permitted for specific instructional use.

A green zone means that general and open use of the device is allowed, such as in the cafeteria.

Students should also be aware of the following:

### Wireless Access

Student use of the district's wifi is through the student or guest network only.

### Technical Support

The district is not responsible for devices brought to school by students. Students assume all responsibility for security and maintenance of their own devices. The district cannot guarantee the necessary time, power or outlets to charge during the school day.

### Cyberbullying and other misbehaviors

A violation of the Code of Conduct is always a violation, even if it takes place in cyberspace, and even if it takes place outside the school network. Bullying, discrimination, harassment, plagiarism and other misdeeds will not be tolerated. Students who violate the AUP will be subject to consequences outlined in the Code of Conduct.
